Malmö – Host city

The region of Skåne, to which Malmö belongs, did not become a part of Sweden until 1658. Before that, Malmö was a part of Denmark. The history of Malmö goes back almost a thousand years. Malmö was given the municipal privileges in 1352.

Malmö is the hub of the Skåne region and Sweden's third largest city and the commercial centre of southern Sweden. Approximately 270 000 people live in Malmö.

The Danish capital Copenhagen is less than half an hour away and connected to Malmö by the mighty Öresund Bridge which was opened in the year 2000.



How to get to Malmö?

By Train

It is easy to travel by train to Malmö. You will find direct trains from Denmark and Germany. It is quick and easy to get from Copenhagen Central Station to the centre of Malmö with the Öresund-trains.

By Air

Copenhagen Airport (CPH), from the airport you cross Öresund Bridge by train and reach the first stop at Malmö Svågertorp (Malmö Syd) in only 12 minutes.

Malmö Airport (MMX) is located 30km south-east of Malmö. Here you have direct flights to and from London, Prague, Stockholm and other European cities.



Following transportation will be provided for delegations that book their accommodation through the OC:

- *From Malmö central station, to the official hotel/youth hostel or competition venue and back.*
- *From and to Kastrup Airport or Malmö Airport*
- *Scheduled shuttle service to competition and training.*

Accommodation

The OC offers 3 packages for your team and delegation members.

The packages include youth hostels or hotels near the competition venue and in the centre of Malmö.

Please book as early as possible to guarantee the package of your choice.



Dinner has to be organized by the delegations themselves. The OC will help you to find solutions to restaurants nearby the hotel or venue.

Catering

Delegations that book their accommodation through the OC will get:

- Breakfast at the hotel/youth hostel
- Lunch at the competition venue
- Banquet



Competition and training venue

The Stadium area is one of Europe's largest sports and recreation centres situated approximately 2 kilometers from the city centre.

Training and Competition venue are directly connected to each other.

Baltiska hallen is a sports and events venue accommodating around 4000 spectators. It is used for handball and basketball training and league games, and is also much used for major sporting events, concerts, shows and galas of various kinds.
